# **Board Meeting Minutes**

March 18, 2015

#### Call to Order:

The meeting was called to order by David Robinson, President, at Pizza Bella at 7:16 PM.

#### Financial:

As of March 1st, the operational checking account balance was \$11,313.50; the reserve account balance was \$35,170.35. Reminder statements were sent to all homeowners with unpaid dues balances.

# **Grounds Report:**

The HOA has contracted with Finch Landscaping for this year's grounds maintenance. Supplies for the Dogipots were ordered. It was decided that two new Dogipots will be added to the neighborhood: one on Stoney Creek Road at the big bend, and one at the end of Stoney Creek Road just before the cul-de-sac. A need for new benches in the park/playground was discussed. Important features to consider are durability and anchorability. David Robinson will research options.

## **Architectural Review Committee Report:**

A window replacement project was approved. The Board will give the solar panel installation guidelines a final review before adding them to the ARC documents.
