<u>APPLICATIONS/ACTIVITY</u>. Since our last report, we have not received any applications.

- asked us to check original house and trim colors, and help select door color. (Note that original house colors are on our website.)

SIGN LANDSCAPING. The plantings approved by the board in the fall have now been planted. When these plants were approved, it was too late in the season to obtain them. At our last meeting Adele suggested we plant colorful spring blooming trees around the sign, such as dogwood, redbud, etc. Let's consider doing this in the fall.

For spring/summer, I suggest we plant some annuals in front of the sign. I recommend short marigolds, yellow and orange. They like sunny spots and are deer and drought resistant. Krista has offered to help me plant some, and perhaps others can help as well, if the board approves.

ROLE OF THE ARC. When the board has come to a decision about the role of the ARC and decided on their position on the ARC Requirements, we will meet to discuss our future.
